The Daytona Beach area includes seven cities and towns – Ormond Beach, Daytona Beach, Daytona Beach Shores, Ponce Inlet, Holly Hill and South Daytona – and is known for its iconic beaches, and so much more.

Experience the rich cultural tapestry of this iconic destination. Embrace your sense of outdoor adventure. Pair your travels with the best in [local cuisine](#). The waterfront views – along 23 miles of beaches, Halifax River and Ponce Inlet – are vast and relaxing. Eclectic historic downtowns and [shopping meccas](#) provide lively backdrops to while away your days. Go off the beaten path to explore some [local history](#).

Famous explorer Ponce de Leon, during his 1513 search for the Fountain of Youth, discovered the now-popular DeLeon Springs, located just west of Daytona Beach. Dr. Andrew Turnbull homesteaded 101,000 acres of land as the New Smyrna colony (now called New Smyrna Beach), just south of Daytona Beach. Matthias Day, a wealthy northern tycoon, was so completely enamored with the entire area that he became the founding father of Daytona (now called Daytona Beach) and built its very first hotel in 1874.



## Airlift & Ground Transportation

The Daytona Beach area is located where two major interstate highways intersect – Interstate 4 and Interstate 95 – and is very accessible whether you're traveling by car or using location transportation options including most major rental car companies . Airlines offering daily non-stop flights into [Daytona Beach International Airport](#), with hundreds of more connections include Delta (from Atlanta) and American Airlines (from Charlotte), with additional seasonal service . Located an hour's drive from Daytona Beach, Orlando International Airport is one of the nation's major airports and is serviced by many domestic and international carriers. Visitors can also use [I-4 Express](#); this new option consists of tolled lanes, two in each direction, in the center of I-4 between Kirkman Road (State Road 435) and State Road 434. [Orlando Sanford Airport](#) International charter and scheduled domestic service are available. The Daytona Beach area is located 35 miles northeast of the Orlando Sanford Airport via Interstate 4.
